

Junior Golf League 2024

(Rules are subject to change depending upon participation)

1) 8 Rounds Played over this timeframe (December 2023 – March 2024)

- a. **Cost: \$200/player**
- b. 9 Holes
- c. Individual Point Quota Format
- d. **HANDICAPS – Starting handicaps will be determined based on your practice round results. Practice Rounds can be played anytime between November 1, 2023 - November 31, 2023.** You may use this time to get familiar to the simulator software and set your starting handicap for the league. Then once scores are recorded during weeks 1-6, the match play weeks, we will calculate handicaps weekly using a “rolling” method (take every score to par, add them up, then average them) and round down (Ex. Rd 1 - +7, Rd 2 - +5, Rd. 3 - +3, your handicap would be a 5)
 - i. **Max Handicap (20)**
 - ii. **Min. Handicap (0)**

2) LEAGUE RULES

- a. Following Point Quota Scoring System will be used for both individual & team formats:
 - i. **Double Bogey or Worse** (0pts)
 - ii. **Bogey** (1pt)
 - iii. **Par** (2pts)
 - iv. **Birdie** (4pts)
 - v. **Eagle** (8pts)
- b. Players individual point quota will be determined by taking their 9-hole handicap and subtracting it from 20 (Ex. 14 handicap for 9-holes, point quota target score would be 6pts.) Standings will be kept for individual & team point quota totals.
- c. Juniors will play from appropriate tee boxes at appropriate distances based on age group.
- d. The top 2 or 3 individual point earners will receive prizes at end of season (**Weekly prizes may be available as well, subject to change based on participation**).
- e. Weekly golf trivia quizzes will be handed out for each round to participants when they come in to play. This will be a way of earning extra points towards their season/weekly total.
- f. Play must be completed within the 16-week timeframe from December 1, 2023, to March 31, 2024, with players being responsible for scheduling their tee times.
- g. We have the discretion to award more time to complete rounds based on individual needs (i.e., medical emergencies, family emergencies, etc.)
- h. Junior Clinic / Q&A session will take place at the conclusion of the league.
- i. Possible Ryder Cup style competition will take place at the end of the league consisting of 2 teams of 4-6 players (Team York vs. Team Lancaster) and 3 match play formats (singles, alternate shot, and better ball) (**Ryder cup is TBD based on participation**)

3) PLAY RULES

- a. Slow green speeds, moderate green conditions, firm terrain firmness
- b. Players will play tees based on age group.
- c. Double bogey will be the max score per hole (i.e., 5 on Par 3's, 6 on Par 4's, 7 on Par 5's). If you get past a double bogey, you can concede the hole on the simulator software.
- d. Auto Putt will be used for putting (balls finishing inside 6 feet of the hole will be awards a 1-putt, anything outside of that will be a 2-putt)
- e. No lie penalties
