

Ladies League 2024 INDOOR LEAGUE PLAY

(Rules are subject to change depending upon participation)

1) 6 Week League (January 7 – February 17, 2024)

- a. **Cost:** \$150
- b. 2 person teams
- c. 9 Holes
- d. Individual & Team Point Quota Format
- e. **HANDICAPS – Starting handicaps will be determined based on your practice round results. Practice Rounds can be played anytime between December 3, 2023 - January 6, 2024.** You may use this time to get familiar to the simulator software and set your starting handicap for the league. Then once scores are recorded during weeks 1-6, the match play weeks, we will calculate handicaps weekly using a “rolling” method (take every score to par, add them up, then average them) and round down (Ex. Rd 1 - +7, Rd 2 - +5, Rd. 3 - +3, your handicap would be a 5)
 - i. **Max Handicap (Men - 18, Women – 20)**
 - ii. **Min. Handicap (Men – 0, Women – 0)**

2) LEAGUE RULES

- a. Following Point Quota Scoring System will be used for both individual & team formats:
 - i. **Double Bogey or Worse** (0pts)
 - ii. **Bogey** (1pt)
 - iii. **Par** (2pts)
 - iv. **Birdie** (4pts)
 - v. **Eagle** (8pts)
- b. Players individual point quota will be determined by taking their 9-hole handicap and subtracting it from 20 (Ex. 14 handicap for 9-holes, point quota target score would be 6pts.) Standings will be kept for individual & team point quota totals.
- c. The top 2 or 3 teams overall based on team points and top 2 or 3 individual point earners will receive prizes (**subject to change based on participation**).
- d. Play for each week can be completed within a 2-week timeframe from Monday-Sunday, with teams being responsible for scheduling their tee times.
- e. If a team or team member cannot complete their round/s before the Sunday bi-weekly deadline, they will be replaced by a “GHOST” player of similar handicap/skill level. **PLEASE NOTE: We will allow teams to play as far in advance as needed.**
- f. We have the discretion to award more time to complete rounds based on individual needs (i.e., medical emergencies, family emergencies, etc.)
- g. Subs will be allowed and encouraged if you're unsure that you will not be able to make it in to play, however we must be contacted prior to their round with your subs name. Subs will start out playing as a 0 handicap (If multiple rounds are played, handicap will form for them.) **PLEASE NOTE: Subs earn points toward your teams' total points, “GHOST” players DO NOT**

3) PLAY RULES

- a. Slow green speeds, moderate green conditions, firm terrain firmness
- b. Players will play from the Red Tees or closest available tee box.
- c. Double bogey will be the max score per hole (i.e., 5 on Par 3's, 6 on Par 4's, 7 on Par 5's). If you get past a double bogey, you can concede the hole on the simulator software.
- d. 15 ft. gimmies (ball must finish INSIDE 15 ft to be deemed a gimmie)
- e. No lie penalties
